## A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE TOWN OF PAYSON FEES AND CHARGES SCHEDULE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025.

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson collects fees and charges for various services that it provides; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-499.15(B)(3), if a municipality proposes to increase the rate of an existing tax or fee it has to provide written notice of the schedule of the proposed increase(s) on the home page of the municipality's website at least sixty (60) days before Schedule is approved or disapproved; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-499.15(F), Subsections A and B of this section do not apply to (1) Any fee adopted pursuant to § 9-463.05; (2) Water and wastewater or rate components; (3) Fees for registration-based classes; (4) Court fees established pursuant to state law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-499.15(B)(3), a notice of the proposed fee schedule has been posted on the home page of the Town of Payson website since March 8, 2024; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-499.15(B)(4), a notice of intent to establish or increase a tax, assessment of fee has been posted on the Town of Payson website at least fifteen (15) days before Schedule is approved or disapproved; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 9-499.15(B)(4), a notice of intent to increase certain fees and charges has been posted on the home page of the Town of Payson website since March 8, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson desires to adopt a comprehensive unified Fee and Charges Schedule for the fiscal year 2024-2025; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson finds that, for budgeting purposes, clarity for citizens, and the convenience of citizens and Town staff alike, it is necessary to have the 2024-2025 Fee and Charges Schedule effective on July 1, 2024: and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council has complied with publication and website posting requirements to assure timely adoption of the Comprehensive Fee and Charges Schedule to provide for an July $1^{\text {st }}, 2024$ effective date.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Fee and Charges Schedule, attached hereto as Exhibit 1, is hereby adopted and shall be effective as of July 1, 2024.

Section 2: That Chris Higgins, Mayor of the Town of Payson, is authorized to execute Resolution No. 3380 to adopt the Fee and Charges Schedule in substantially the form attached.

Section 3: That the Town of Payson officials are authorized to take such other and further actions as may be necessary or appropriate to carrying out the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4: If any section of Exhibit 1 to this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of Exhibit 1.

## 2024/2025 Fees and Charges Schedule

Effective July 1, 2024
Resolution No. 3380

The fee schedule for the Town of Payson, which is to be enacted on July 1, 2024, shall be as follows, subject to administration fees and outside costs where applicable.

ADMINISTRATION FEE: An administration fee of $10 \%$ may be added to all fees and charges listed herein whenever outside costs are incurred.

OUTSIDE COSTS: Outside costs are generally all costs of services and materials billed to the Town and shall include, but are not limited to, costs of publication and posting; attorney fees; filing fees; reproduction costs; outside engineering, surveying and consulting services.

DEPOSITS: No interest shall accrue to any deposit.
REFUNDS: All refunds of $\$ 5.00$ or more will be issued by check to the last known address the Town has for the person entitled to the refund. No refunds under $\$ 5.00$ will be issued unless the person entitled to the refund affirmatively requests such refund. If no such request is made within 30 days, such amount below $\$ 5.00$ shall be deemed donated to the Town.

Note: Except as may be noted otherwise, fees and charges are non-refundable.

The Town shall calculate the building valuation data as required by any code adopted pursuant to this chapter by utilizing the most current building valuation data as determined from time to time, and published by the International Code Council.

## New Home \& Commercial Fee Calculation

A) Calculate building value by using the appropriate area calculation for the type of occupancy as provided in the most current issue of the Building Standards magazine produced by the ICC.
B) Determine the Building Permit fee using valuation table 3-A.
C) See miscellaneous fees listed in tables 3-B through E.
D) Plan Review fees are calculated by multiplying the Building Permit fee by $65 \%$.
E) Add: B + C + D above to calculate total building permit fee.
